Behavioural Issue / Classroom Disruption

NON-DISRUPTIVE BEHAVIOUR

or

SERIOUS ACTS OF MISCONDUCT

RTP

Non-Disruptive Behaviour eg.

- not completing work
- not prepared for class
- inappropriate use of technology

Serious Acts of Misconduct eg.

- bullying
- cheating
- swearing at teacher
- stealing
- vandalism

Behaviour that disrupts the learning of others eg.

- talking
- calling out
- late to class
- not following classroom expectations

Remind Students of expectations. Classroom Management Practices eg.

- seating change
- reminders
- redirect

Send Student to reception immediately (32351)

Detail the incident and give report to PC Coordinator

1st Time Questions

- What are you doing?
- What are the rules?
- Is that ok?
- What happens if you disrupt again?

Continues...

- email or phone parents / caregiver and cc all correspondence to PC team
- follow RTP Process if behaviour becomes a disruption

Student will be counselled by the following:

1. **PC Coordinator;**
2. **APWA;**
3. **A member of the leadership team.**

2nd Time Questions

- What are you doing?
- What did you say would happen?

RTC

The College Counsellor and HOD may also be involved. Depending on the severity of the behaviour the student may spend time planning in the board room or at home. Exclusion may result. A meeting with the parent / caregiver will be required.

Student returns to class through RTP process.
