To conform to Occupational Health and Safety Requirements, students doing practical workshop subjects will be required to **provide their own CLEAR safety glasses and hearing protection (Howard Leight QB3 Semi-aural headband earplug)** and **steelcap work boots**. In addition to the above, students will be required to provide and bring to all practical classes, a suitable pencil and 5 metre retractable tape measure. Most vocational studies students involved in structured work placement will be required to supply the above whilst at work.

Certificate II in Engineering Pathways:	Students will be required to have industry standard protective clothing as worn in the engineering work places. Minimum protective clothing would be cotton overalls and steel cap work boots or long cotton work trousers with a long sleeved cotton shirt.

Textbook Issue Dates

All textbooks (except English) will be issued to students in the week **BEFORE** school starts. Please make this a priority so that classes can begin on day one. The library will be open to issue textbooks to all students on:

- Tuesday 19 January 2021 8:30 am - 3:30 pm
- Wednesday 20 January 2021 8:30 am - 3:30 pm

Students have multiple options to collect their texts:

1. Collect textbooks in the final staff week of school 2020
2. Personal visit and wait for collection – same day service
3. Drop off your subject list in the morning and collect textbooks later in the day
4. Phone ahead from Monday 18 January and book a time to collect their textbooks
5. Email your name, preferred collection time (see above times) and complete subject list to library@stpats.qld.edu.au The emails will not be answered until our return on Monday 18 January

After this time, students will be able to collect their textbooks during the school day at the following times: Before school 7.30-8.30am, morning tea 10.35-10.53am, lunch 12.49-1.34pm, after school 3.00-4.00pm.

Lockers

Lockers are available to all students for the purpose of securing textbooks and personal belongings at a cost of \$15 per locker. You will have the use of the locker for the entire time you are at the College.

To secure yourself a locker, please complete the electronic form which is available from the College App.

When collecting textbooks in January, please report firstly to Reception whereby you will be issued with a locker number and code.

AFTER collecting textbooks, you may place them in your locker and secure it.

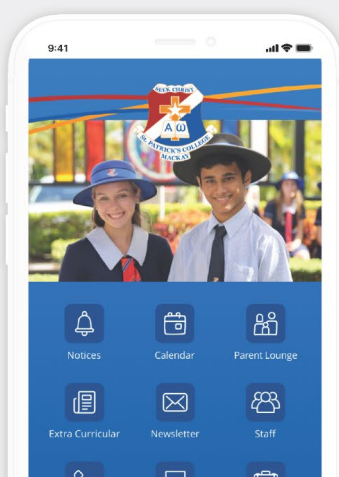
